



# FY 2025 NOFO - PROJECT TYPES

1. New CoC Bonus Projects
2. New DV Bonus Projects
3. New Projects Created Through Reallocation

Plus all Renewal Projects for currently funded grantees.

## 1 RAPID REHOUSING (RRH) – NEW AND RENEWAL

### Purpose

- Moves households experiencing homelessness quickly into permanent housing.
- Focuses on stabilization, income, education, health, and long-term housing success.

### Eligible as:

- New CoC Bonus
- DV Bonus
- Reallocation
- Renewal (if currently funded)

## 2 PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING (PSH) – NEW AND RENEWAL

Provides long-term rental assistance and intensive services for persons with disabilities.

### Purpose

- Serves chronically homeless individuals and families.
- Focuses on long-term stability, recovery, and reducing system cycling.

### Important FY 2025 Restriction

Permanent Housing (PSH, RRH, Joint) may not exceed 30 percent of the CoC's ARD.

### Eligible as:

- New CoC Bonus (only if CoC stays under 30 percent PH cap)
- Reallocation
- Renewal

## 3 TRANSITIONAL HOUSING (TH) – NEW AND RENEWAL

HUD is “welcoming” TH projects again this year.

### Purpose

- Provides time-limited housing with services
- Often paired with recovery, treatment, stabilization, or re-entry populations.

### Eligible as:

- New CoC Bonus
- Reallocation
- Renewal

## 4 SUPPORTIVE SERVICES ONLY (SSO) – NEW AND RENEWAL

FY 2025 strongly supports SSO, especially SSO Outreach.

### Purpose

- Provides services only (no housing)
- Outreach, engagement, case management, transportation, linkage to treatment
- Public safety emphasis (law enforcement and first responder partnerships)

### Eligible as:

- New CoC Bonus
- Reallocation
- Renewal

## 5 Coordinated Entry (CE) – New and Renewal

New CE projects must improve system-wide access, assessment, prioritization, and referral.

### Purpose

- Strengthens the CoC's intake and referral system
- Ensures compliance with HUD assessment standards and fairness protections

### Eligible as:

- Reallocation
- CoC Bonus (if justified)
- Renewal

## 6 Domestic Violence (DV) Bonus Projects

Must exclusively serve survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, or stalking.

### Types Allowed:

- DV RRH
- DV Coordinated Entry
- DV Joint Component (Renewals Only – HUD is not allowing NEW Joint projects)
- DV SSO projects supporting safety, housing navigation, or relocation

### Purpose

- Increase safety, confidentiality, housing access, and trauma-informed support

## 7 Joint TH RRH (Joint Component) – Renewal Only

### HUD is explicit:

NOT Eligible as New in FY 2025

- NO new Joint TH RRH
- Only renewals of currently funded Joint projects

## 8 YHDP (Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program) Renewal and Replacement

These follow separate rules but are still submitted through the CoC process.

## 9 CoC Planning Grant (Collaborative Applicant Only)

Not a project for agencies to apply for — only ARCH can submit.

## FY2025 HUD COC COMPETITION

### REQUIRED ITEMS FOR ALL PROJECT APPLICANTS (NEW & RENEWAL)

#### 1 UNIQUE ENTITY IDENTIFIER (UEI) – REQUIRED

Every agency applying must have an active UEI (formerly DUNS).

- Must match SAM.gov
- Must match e-snaps profile
- Must be active and not expired

HUD will reject applications without a valid UEI.

#### 2 ACTIVE SAM.GOV REGISTRATION – REQUIRED

Must be:

- Active
- Not expired
- Matches agency legal name
- Matches UEI

HUD requires this for contracting and payment.

#### 3 E-SNAPS APPLICANT PROFILE – REQUIRED

Must be:

- Updated for FY 2025
- Accurate and consistent with SAM.gov
- Uploaded with correct attachments

HUD will not review incomplete applicant profiles.

#### 4 FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AND INTERNAL CONTROLS – REQUIRED

Applicants must demonstrate:

- Financial capacity
- Internal controls
- Ability to meet HUD reimbursement requirements
- No unresolved HUD findings
- No disallowed costs or open OIG audits

#### 5 Match (25 percent of total eligible costs) – REQUIRED

Must include:

- Approved match letter
- Allowable sources (cash, in-kind, services, government support)
- Must be secured at application

#### 6 Proof of Site Control (for housing-based projects)

Required for:

- RRH
- PSH
- TH
- Joint Component (renewals only)

Not required for SSO or CE.

#### 7 Housing First Compliance

HUD requires all projects to:

- Remove barriers
- Allow applicants to enter housing without preconditions
- Not terminate for sobriety or service participation only
- Prioritize participant choice and voluntary service engagement

#### 8 Staffing Plan and Qualifications

Must include:

- Adequate staffing levels
- Organizational capacity
- Case manager qualifications
- Law enforcement/public safety partnership if claiming those points
- Licensure if providing clinical services

#### 9 CoC Planning Grant (Collaborative Applicant Only)

HUD reviews:

- Permanent housing exits
- Returns to homelessness
- Income growth
- Utilization
- Coordinated Entry usage
- Equity and fairness protections

#### 10 Required Policies and Procedures

Applicants must upload or have ready:

- Coordinated Entry participation policy
- Safety planning (for DV)
- Drug-free workplace
- HMIS participation (or DV comparable database)
- Confidentiality protocols
- VAWA compliance
- Equal Access compliance
- Nondiscrimination and fair housing policies
